## NOTE

- Students must wear black leather lace up school shoes. This is for health and safety reasons in technical classrooms such as science and food technology labs. Girls are not permitted to wear low cut ballet style leather shoes as their feet are exposed to risks.

### Legislation

Under the NSW Occupations Health and Safety Act 2000 (OH&S Act) the DET must ensure that students are not exposed to risks to their health or safety while they are on Departmental Premises.

- Proper sports shoes are also required for support and safety during practical lessons. Shoes such as Rabens are not permitted as they do not meet requirements of a functional sporting shoe.
- Students must arrive at and leave school in full school uniform at all times except for Years 8, 9, 10 and 11 on Tuesdays. Students are allowed time to change into and out of PE uniform at the beginning and end of each PE lesson.
- Students must wear the correct school uniform, without any addition of non-uniform items, on the way to and from school.
- On Tuesdays when there is sport, students in Years 8, 9, 10 and 11 may wear their full PDHPE/Sport uniform and/or tracksuit to school. If they have a lesson in Industrial Arts, Food Technology, DAT and/or Science, they must bring and wear their black leather lace up school shoes in that lesson for safety reasons.
- No makeup is to be worn and no jewellery/adornment (except for a watch, sleepers or studs) is to be visible while students are in school uniform.
- Hair restraints must be discreet and in school colours.
- Students wearing a hijab should ensure that the colour is either maroon, black or white, in keeping with the school colours.
- School uniform is to be worn during examinations and excursions unless students and parents are notified otherwise.
- Students must wear the uniform designated for their year.
- If senior students choose to wear ties they must have their top button done up and the tie worn in the traditional manner.
- Students wishing to wear additional clothing for extra warmth in winter must ensure this is not visible eg. no skivvies or round necked tee shirts. No coloured undergarments are to be visible through shirts or blouses.
